

2026 TERMS & CONDITIONS

ENTRY SUBMISSION AND FEE

- There is a limit of three entries per artist. The art must be the original work of the artist, and the item must not have been previously entered in the Sandy Point Art Show.
- Open Entry fee for each art piece is \$10. Junior (18 years or below) entry fee for each art piece is \$5.
- All entries must be for sale. Payment for art works sold will be credited to your nominated account (submitted on the Entry Form).
- A commission of 20% will be charged on all sales. Proceeds from the sale will go towards the Sandy Point Community Centre.
- Entry Forms must be received by **Sunday 1 March 2026. No late entries will be accepted**.

CATEGORIES

There is a winner and runner up prize awarded for each category unless there are fewer than five items entered in the category. If there are fewer than five items entered, only a first prize will be awarded. Prizes are also awarded for Best in Show and People's Choice.

All categories are professionally judged. As our judges are volunteers, they reserve the right to remain anonymous. The Art Group reserves the right to decide if artwork should not be displayed.

In the Open Art section there are seven categories using the following mediums:

- Oil painting
- Acrylic painting
- Watercolour painting (art must be at least 80% watercolour)
- Drawing (Pastel, Pencil & Ink)
- Mixed Media (including Earth Pigment)
- Photography (Traditional and Digitally modified)
- Sculpture (any medium that is 3D including ceramics & mosaics).

The Junior Art section will be judged in five age categories based on the following school level:

- Prep to Year 3
- Year 4 to 6
- Year 7 and 8
- Year 9 and 10
- Year 11 and 12.

ENTRY DELIVERY & COLLECTION

- Entries are to be delivered to the Sandy Point Community Centre between **1pm 3pm on Saturday 28 March 2026**. Late entries will not be accepted.
- All paintings and photos must be ready for hanging on a secured wire or cord. **Entries not ready to be hung cannot be accepted.**
- Art pieces must be clearly marked on the back with:
 - o the artist's name and address
 - o the title, medium and price.
- All details must align with your Entry Form no substitutes or name changes will be accepted.
- Collection of unsold entries from **4.30pm 6pm Monday 6 April 2026** (unless by prior arrangement).

All care will be taken with the art. The Sandy Point Art Group will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage incurred to entries. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
